## The Significance of the Abrahamic Covenant

1. It reveals God's desire to bless all peoples (Gentiles).

2. It reveals God's purpose for the Church in the Present Age (The Great Commission).

3. It reveals God's faithfulness to Israel and the Covenants He made with her. He will fulfill His promises (Rom. 11).

## Second Landmark of Israel: Israel's Consecration

- Continuity of the Covenant from the Patriarchs to Moses
  - -The Patriarchs' desire to be in the land (Gen. 50)
  - -God's Self-Revelation (Exod. 3:14-15)

# Second Landmark of Israel: *Israel's Consecration*

- The Passover (Four Lessons)
  - Israel's redemption is by grace through faith.
  - God's grace and mercy are extended to those who express faith in God in the midst of His judgment.
  - God's provision of escape (forgiveness of sin) comes through a blood sacrifice.
  - Redemption always involves substitutionary death (vicarious atonement).
