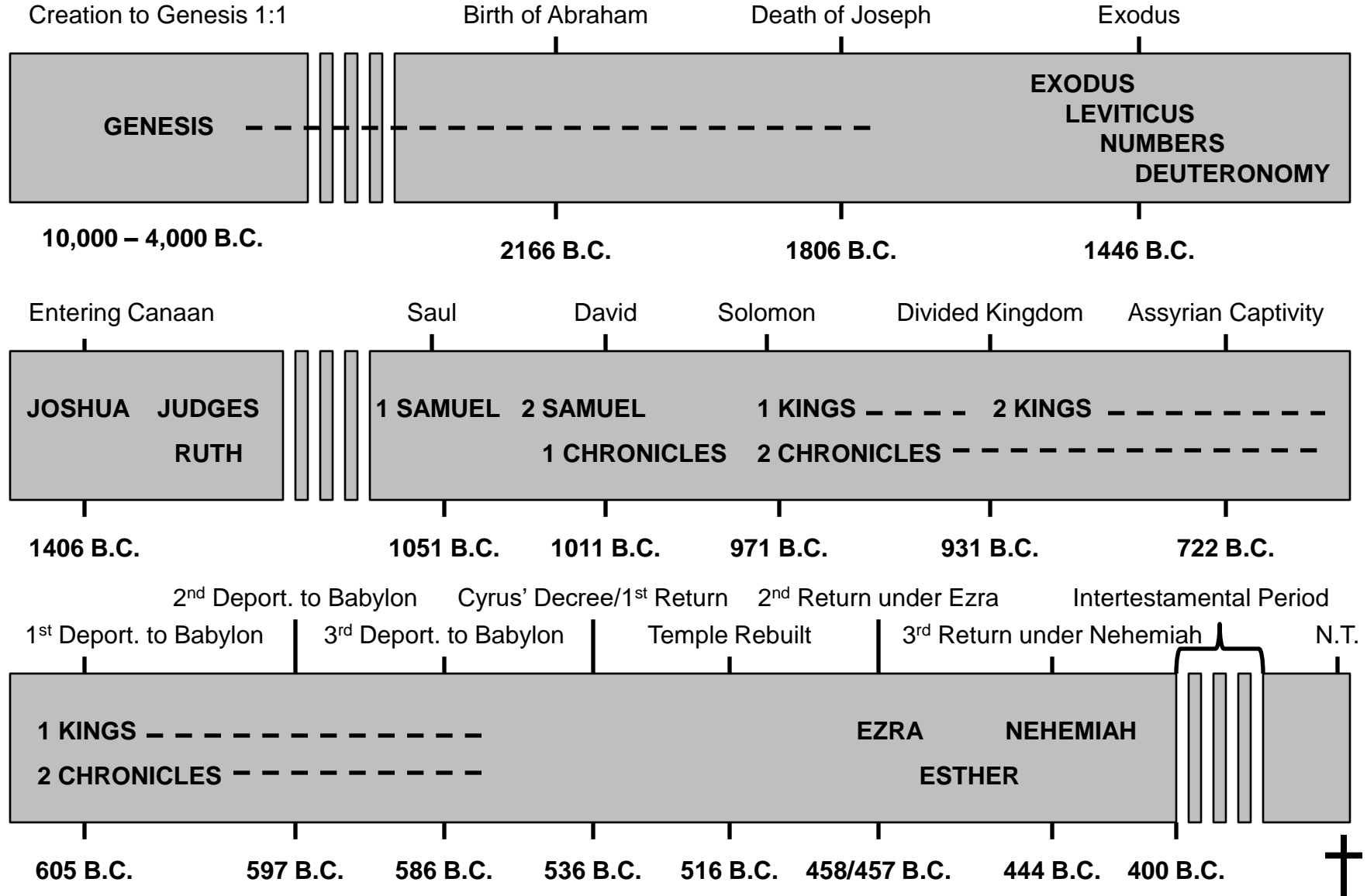

Book of Covenant Compromise

- III. Results of the Compromise: **Epilogue** (17:1–21:25)

The Theme Verse for the Book of Judges

- “In those days Israel had no king;
everyone did as he saw fit” (Judg. 21:25)

2 Reasons for Israel's Failures as Depicted in the Prologue (1:1–2:5)

1. **Physical or military compromise** with surrounding nations
2. **Spiritual or religious compromise** with the surrounding nations' idols

Israel's 6 Cycles of Compromise *Documented in Judges 2:6–16:31*

1. First Cycle: **Arameans** (8 yrs.)
2. Second Cycle: **Moabites** (18 yrs.)
3. Third Cycle: **Canaanites** (20 yrs.)
4. Fourth Cycle: **Midianites** (7 yrs.)
5. Fifth Cycle: **Philistines & Ammonites** (18 yrs.)
6. Sixth Cycle: **Philistines** (40 yrs.)

CYCLES OF SLAVERY IN JUDGES
