# The “Farewell Discourse” of Jesus in John 13–17

- Context: The night before Jesus was crucified
- Purpose: To prepare His disciples for His imminent departure
- 2 Main Themes:
  1. Love one another
  2. Stay faithful

- 5. Relationships*

- *To God (Father, Son, Holy Spirit)*

- To one another

- *To the world*

# The Holy Spirit

- The Third Person of the Triune God (Father, Son, Holy Spirit)
- Co-Eternal with the Father & the Son
- He shares all the divine attributes with the Father & the Son.
- The Paraclete: “Counselor,” “Advocate,” “Comforter,” “Helper,” etc.

# The Holy Spirit

- *6 Characteristics of the Person of the Holy Spirit (John 14:15-17):*

1. He is a Gift from the Father.
2. He is a separate Person from the Father and the Son.
3. He will be with believers forever.

# The Holy Spirit

- *6 Characteristics of the Person of the Holy Spirit (John 14:15-17):*

4. He is the Revealer of truth.
5. He is known only to believers.
6. He will not only be with believers forever but will indwell them.

# The Holy Spirit

- *3 Additional Works of the Holy Spirit (John 14:25-27):*
  1. He represents Jesus to believers.
  2. He teaches & reminds the words of Jesus to believers.
  3. He imparts the supernatural peace of Jesus to believers.

# The Holy Spirit

- *His ministry to the world (John 16:9-11): He will convict the world of guilt*

...

1. *In regard to sin*
2. *In regard to righteousness*
3. *In regard to judgment*

# The Holy Spirit

- *His ministry for the believers (John 16:12-33):*

- 1. Guidance to & Illumination of God's truth (vv. 12-15)*
- 2. Source of supernatural Comfort & Joy (vv. 16-33)*
