### The "Farewell Discourse" of Jesus in John 13–17

- Context: The night before Jesus was crucified
- Purpose: To prepare His disciples for His imminent departure
- 2 Main Themes:
  - 1. Love one another
  - 2. Stay faithful

#### Jesus' "Farewell Discourse" (cont.)

- Jesus' Teaching for His disciples:
  - 1. Loving Servant-Leadership
  - 2. His Imminent Departure
  - 3. The Holy Spirit
  - 4. The Community
  - 5. Relationships
  - To God (Father, Son, Holy Spirit)
    - To one another
  - To the world

- The <u>Third Person</u> of the Triune God (Father, Son, Holy Spirit)
- Co-Eternal with the Father & the Son
- He shares all the <u>divine attributes</u> with the Father & the Son.
- The <u>Paraclete</u>: "Counselor," "Advocate," "Comforter," "Helper," etc.

 6 Characteristics of the <u>Person</u> of the <u>Holy Spirit</u> (John 14:15-17):

- 1. He is a Gift from the Father.
- 2. He is a <u>separate Person</u> from the Father and the Son.
- 3. He will be with believers forever.

 6 Characteristics of the Person of the Holy Spirit (John 14:15-17):

- 4. He is the Revealer of truth.
- 5. He is known only to believers.
- 6. He will not only be <u>with</u> believers forever but will <u>indwell</u> them.

- 3 Additional Works of the Holy Spirit (John 14:25-27):
- 1. He <u>represents Jesus</u> to believers.
- 2. He <u>teaches & reminds</u> the <u>words of</u> <u>Jesus</u> to believers.
- 3. He imparts the supernatural <u>peace of Jesus</u> to believers.

• His ministry to the world (John 16:9-11): He will convict the world of guilt

- 1. In regard to sin
- 2. In regard to righteousness
- 3. In regard to judgment

• His ministry for the <u>believers</u> (John 16:12-33):

- 1. Guidance to & Illumination of God's truth (vv. 12-15)
- 2. Source of supernatural Comfort & Joy (vv. 16-33)
