- 1. Pre-tribulational Rapture**
- 2. Post-tribulational Rapture**
- 3. Mid-tribulational Rapture**

Some Facts about the Great Tribulation

1. It is Daniel's 70th Week of Prophecy given for the Nation Israel (Dan. 9:24-27).
2. It is the "Time of Jacob's Trouble" in Jeremiah's prophecy (Jer. 30:7), which will be immediately followed by the fulfillment of the New Covenant to Israel (Jer. 31, 33).
3. It is the "Time of great distress" for the Nation Israel that is unequaled in all history (Dan. 12:1; Matt. 24:21, 29), when Jews will be persecuted (Rev. 12:17).

Some Facts about the Great Tribulation (cont.)

4. It is the “hour of trial” that is going to come on the whole world (Rev. 3:10).
5. It is the period during which the “Beast” of Daniel’s prophecy or the Antichrist will manifest himself to the world (Dan. 7:7, 24; 2 Thess. 2:3; Rev. 13:1).
6. It is the period of time for which the Antichrist will make a peace-treaty with the Jews (7 yrs.), but break it in the middle of that period and will begin to persecute them.

Some Facts about the Great Tribulation (cont.)

- 7. It is the period of time during which 2/3 of Israel will be killed (Zech. 13:8-9).**
- 8. It is the period during which the “Beast out of the earth” or the False Prophet will perform many miracles to deceive the people of the earth (Rev. 13:11-18; 2 Thess. 2:9).**
- 9. It is the period in which the “gospel of the kingdom” will be preached (Matt. 24:14) by the 144,000 Jews to the whole world supernaturally (Rev. 7:1-8).**

Some Facts about the Great Tribulation (cont.)

10. It is the period in which the whole earth will be catastrophically chaotic militarily, economically, geographically, geologically, astronomically, and spiritually, as the Seal Judgments, the Trumpet Judgments, and the Bowl Judgments are poured out on the earth.

Some Notable Differences between the Rapture of the Church & the Second Advent of Christ

Rapture of the Church

1. The church will meet Christ in the air (1 Thess. 4:17).
2. The church will be taken to heaven (1 Thess. 4:17).
3. Christ will come for His saints (2 Thess. 2:1).
4. Christ Himself will gather the saints (1 Thess. 4:16).

Second Advent of Christ

1. The church will return to the earth with Christ (Zech. 14:4).
2. The church will return to the earth from heaven (Jude 14).
3. Christ will come with His saints (1 Thess. 3:13; Rev. 19:14).
4. The angels will gather the elect (Matt. 24:31).

Some Notable Differences between the Rapture of the Church & the 2nd Advent of Christ

Rapture of the Church

5. Believers will be caught up out from among unbelievers (1 Thess. 4:16-17).
6. Satan will not be bound.
7. The righteous will be removed from the earth (1 Thess. 4:17).
8. No signs will be leading up to the rapture (1 Thess. 5:4).

Second Advent of Christ

5. Unbelievers ('tares') will be gathered first (Matt. 13:41-43).
6. Satan will be bound (Rev. 20:3).
7. The wicked will be removed (Matt. 25:40-41).
8. Signs will precede the return of Christ (Matt. 24:24).
